

Karioi Project after school care program starting Term 3



While you're working, you want to know that your kids are having an awesome time and being cared for after school hours.

Parents can now relax, with the start of a new After School Care program at Raglan Area School, starting in Term 3.

The program, run by the Karioi Project team, is based on a free play philosophy – meaning kids get to do what they love – play as they like, for as long as they like, in an unstructured environment.

Amber Jones, a trained teacher with 15 years' experience in early childhood and outdoor based education is the program leader. She says that while there is no set program, there will be many opportunities for students

to explore the school grounds, unwind and be creative, participate in activities or use the time to get homework done or read a book.

The program will run each day from 2.30 to 6 pm for students aged 5 – 14 years. Pick-ups will be available from the Te Uku and Te Mata School bus drop off at Raglan Area School at 3.30 pm too. Parents can pick up their kids anytime.

Bookings can be made on a set or casual basis. The cost for each session is between \$27 - \$32 and includes a light snack.
